

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OVERVIEW OF KIEP & KIEP 250+

The Kenya Industry and Entrepreneurship Project (KIEP) is a private sector support programme being implemented by the Ministry of Investments, Trade and Industry (MITI) with support from the World Bank.

KIEP consists of three components:


- 1. Strengthening the innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem
- 2.SME Linkages and Upgrading
- 3. Project implementation support and M&E

This Business Development Service (BDS) providers application guide deals with Component 2 - SME Linkages and Upgrading (branded, KIEP 250+). The aim of KIEP 250+ is to increase productivity and innovation within established SMEs in Kenya by supporting select private sector firms to improve their managerial and technical skills and their access to and use of technology, in order to significantly increase operational competitiveness.

KIEP 250+ targets to work with at least 250 SMEs across various manufacturing and trade-exposed sectors, and/or SMEs who already supply - or wish to supply - large(r) firms in Kenya.

Shortlisted SMEs accepted into the project will receive an integrated package of diagnostic and advisory services and financial support (performance-based grant funding) for the implementation of technical assistance to address identified gaps in order to increase innovation, productivity and competitiveness.

KIEP 250+ is managed by a consortium of international development consulting firms led by NIRAS Finland Oy ("the Fund Manager"), with Intellecap Advisory Services Private Limited Kenya as a supporting partner. The major part of the implementation will be carried out by NIRAS Africa Ltd of Kenya, which is part of the NIRAS Group. NIRAS Finland Oy and NIRAS Africa Oy will be referred to jointly as NIRAS.







BDS PROVIDERS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

KIEP 250+ aims to improve businesses through provision of Technical Assistance (TA) to address identified business gaps/intervention areas. The TA will be provided by Business Development Service (BDS) providers, selected from a list of screened BDS providers.

To participate in KIEP 250+ as a BDS provider, you need to meet the following minimum qualifications:

- · Be duly registered in Kenya;
- Be at least 3 years old with 2 years' experience in Business Development Service (BDS) provision;
- Should be able to clearly state your area of expertise; where possible professional qualifications should be mentioned;
- · Should have demonstrated experience and knowledge of working with SMEs in BDS provision;
- Should have at least 5 SME clients for whom you have successfully completed business development services:
- · Must be prepared to show an extract of work performed;
- Must be prepared to name two SME clients as references who may potentially be contacted by the KIEP 250 Team;
- · Must be prepared to sign a code of conduct with the Fund Manager.

In certain cases, international BDS providers may be considered.

APPLICATION PROCESS


The following steps are a guide on how to log on, fill in and submit your application for KIEP 250+

SETTING UP AN ACCOUNT


1. Visit the KIEP 250+ website under https://250plus.kiep.go.ke and click on "Apply now"




2. Click **"APPLY NOW"**, select the BDS providers option then proceed to fill the registration form. Upon completion, click **"REGISTER"**



3. Check the inbox of the e-mail address you used to register for KIEP 250+. You will get an email with a code which will allow you to verify your registration.




4. On the website, insert the code that you have received by email.



5. After clicking on "activate", you will be asked to log-on. Use the e-mail you provided (this is your username) and the password you typed in at step 2.




6. Next, you will see the Privacy Notice to which you have to agree before being able to use **SmartME.** Please read this carefully and accept the terms to continue.



Note: You can log-on whenever you want to work on your application. For this, go to the KIEP 250+ website, https://250plus.kiep.go.ke, click on "Apply now", then on "Already have an account? Sign in here."




7. Once you have logged-in successfully, you will land on the home page in **SmartME**.



Note: If you would like a tutorial on how to use the SmartME system, kindly click on the video at the bottom right of the home page.

8. Click on "Applications" to access the application forms. The system is built in such a manner that both application forms for SMEs and Business Development Service (BDS) Providers are accessible to any applicant. If you are a Business Development Services Provider, select the appropriate application form to apply.



Before filling in the application form, please take note of the following:

- · You can save your application and resume where you left off.
- The application form automatically logs out after 120 minutes. This protects your privacy.
- SmartME saves data entered frequently and automatically. You do not have to fill in the information in one go. Click on "save as draft" before logging-out.
- You can submit a BDS provider application at any time during the project period. However, it is
 highly recommended to submit your application as soon as is possible. This will allow for you to
 be included (upon approval) in the BDS providers database where SMEs check for potential BDS
 providers they can engage for their various business improvement interventions.

Note: The BDS providers database is published on the project website.







GUIDELINES FOR ANSWERING THE QUESTIONS

Fill out the application form directly in the system. The following information will guide you on how to fill out the form:


1. Any questions with an **asterisk (*)** means that this is a compulsory question. It must be filled. If for any reason this does not apply to you, you may put **N/A** where text is required or **'0'** where numbers are required.




2. Whenever you see "Please select", this indicates there are predefined options. Click on the arrow to reveal the 'drop down menu' and select the most appropriate response




3. Take note that each question that requires information to be keyed in has a maximum word limit. Once the word limit is reached, no more text can be input.




4. Some questions contain a description text. It provides additional information on how to answer the questions asked.



5. Some questions come with examples provided to assist you in answering the question or further clarify what specific information the KIEP 250+ project is looking for. To access these examples, simply click on the grey question mark icons



6. Kindly note that you cannot submit the application without having filled in the compulsory fields, which are marked with an **asterisk (*)**. When clicking submit, the system will show you which compulsory fields are vacant.






REQUIRED DOCUMENTS


These are summarized in Section 3 of the application form and are listed below:

- · Current tax compliance certificate
- · CVs of Technical Experts listed
- · Upload a sample of past work performed
- Copies of any professional licenses and/or certifications obtained
- Certificate of registration / Business registration document
- · CR12/Shareholder certificate
- · Company profile

The above list provides an overview of the documents you need to have ready for uploading in the system as part of your application.

In terms of types of document formats that are accepted in the system, KIEP 250+ accepts documents in PDF format, maximum size 3MB per attachment; and images in JPG or PNG formats.









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
